CONTINGENT ORDER OF EXCLUSION

THIS MATTER having come before the undersigned judge and Exclusion Community Panel on December 11, 2014 and on January 5, 2015,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the defendant is excluded from all areas within the exterior boundaries of the Lummi Reservation, EXCEPT THAT the defendant may continue to remain within the reservation if he complies with the following requirements.

- 1) Must report at least one time a month to the Lummi Probation Office or more frequently as directed by the probation officer;
 - 2) May not commit any criminal law violations;
 - 2) May not be knowingly present where drugs are being illegally sold or used;
- 3) Must be employed, actively seeking employment, performing full-time child care, attending school, participating in vocational training;
- 4) Must abstain from alcohol and non-prescribed drugs; must submit to a random urine analysis and portable breath test(s) on a schedule determined by the probation officer; and must submit to a portable breath test by a police officer who has reasonable basis to believe defendant has consumed alcohol;
 - 5) Must perform 100 hours of Community Work Service a year;
 - 6) Must complete current sex offender treatment plan;
- 7) The defendant is prohibited from being on the grounds of the Lummi Nation School and from attending any Lummi Nation School activities;
- 8) The defendant may attend funerals and other community events, family dinners, family gatherings and events only while under adult supervision;
 - 9) The defendant may engage in ceremonial hunting, if he obtains guns rights;
- 10) The defendant must obtain a Tribal Elder as mentor and meet with the mentor on a regular basis; and
- 11) The defendant shall notify the Court within 72 hours of moving his residence onto the Lummi Reservation.

The Court will set the case for review approximately one year from of the date of this Order and at that time, the defendant shall be required to provide updated reports from:


- a) Department of Corrections officer as to Defendant's compliance with probation conditions;
- b) Lummi Probation Department;
- c) Dr. Matthew Platte, Defendant's current sex offender treatment provider; and
- d) Defendant's Mentor.

If Court determines by the preponderance of the evidence that the defendant failed to comply with the conditions of the contingent order of exclusion, the person will be excluded from all areas within the exterior boundaries of the Lummi Reservation.

Once the defendant has complied with these conditions for five years, the Conditional Order of Exclusion shall be lifted.
