THIS MATTER having come before the undersigned judge after review by the Exclusion Community Panel and they make recommendations to this Court:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the defendant is excluded from all areas within the exterior boundaries of the Lummi Reservation, EXCEPT THAT the defendant may continue to remain within the reservation if he complies with the following requirements pursuant to LCL§ 12.06.040:

1) Must report at least one time a month to the Lummi Probation Officer or more frequently as directed by the probation officer;

2) May not be convicted of any new violent criminal or any new criminal offense for which the maximum jail sentence would be more than 365 days;

2) May not be knowingly present where drugs are being illegally sold or used;

3) Must be employed, actively seeking employment, performing full-time child-care, attending school, participating in vocational training;

4) Must abstain from alcohol and non-prescribed drugs; must submit to random urine analysis and portable breath test(s) on a schedule determined by the probation officer, and must submit to a portable breath test by a police officer who has a reasonable basis to believe the defendant has consumed alcohol;

5) Must complete an evaluation with Lummi Behavioral health and comply with all treatment recommendations

6) Must participate in family support counseling and follow any treatment recommendations

7) Must complete a substance abuse evaluation and follow all treatment recommendations/ The respondent shall seek substance abuse support from John Jefferson, Willie Lane, and/or Victor Solomon.

8) Must complete an anger management evaluation and follow all treatment recommendations
